#### A WORK TO DO

In the beginning, there was "not a man to till the ground." (Gn 2: 5 KJV) God had created mankind with a purpose and gave them work to do. God said the male and female were to have dominion over all the earth. (Gn 1:26) The Bible is a testimony of productive work. Whether it is man's work to fulfill the dominion mandate or the redemptive work of Jesus Christ, God in the flesh, we are called to live a life of purposeful action.

#### FEAR OF THE LORD CENTRAL TO THE HEBREW PEOPLE

A man of the times, King Solomon was known for his understanding, and even today, his wisdom is renowned even by those unfamiliar with most of the Bible. As the premier author of the Proverbs, referred to as the "manual of wisdom for the living," Solomon had "Been there / Done That," as they say. He looked back over his life, a life complete with throngs of women, immense riches, the building of palaces and temples, and a reputation as an intelligent, worldly, and sophisticated man. But in the end, he knew his duty was to "Fear God, and keep His commandments." (Ecc. 12:13)

The concept of fearing God was central to the Hebrew people and was the beginning of all wisdom. (Prov. 9:10) A wise man was considered industrious, never lazy, and slothful. (Prov. 6: 6-11) and likewise, in Proverbs 31, King Lemuel recalls his mother's sage advice concerning

leadership, justice, and the type of woman to seek (Many biblical scholars believe King Lemuel was Solomon). A woman should also be wise, industrious, and productive.

#### DILIGENCE VERSUS LAZINESS

The Hebrew people had an intimate relationship with God and understood they were to be busy people, not busy just for the sake of it, but recognizing every work and effort to be a gift from God. (Ecc. 2:24) Paul carried this theme into the New Testament when he told the church at Colosse to work heartily as if it were for the Lord and not men. (Col. 3:23)

Just as diligence was considered honorable, laziness was scorned. A lazy man was more prone to poverty. " He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich." (Prov. 10:4) And in Proverbs 24:30-34, sloth is directly tied together with the lack of wisdom or understanding, and the reader is warned to be careful because it can sneak up on you a little at a time.

"I went by the field of the slothful, and by the vineyard of the man void of understanding; And, lo, it was all grown over with thorns, and nettles had covered the face thereof, and the stone wall thereof was broken down. Then I saw, and considered it well: I looked upon it, and received instruction. Yet a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep: So shall thy poverty come as one that travelleth; and thy want as an armed man."

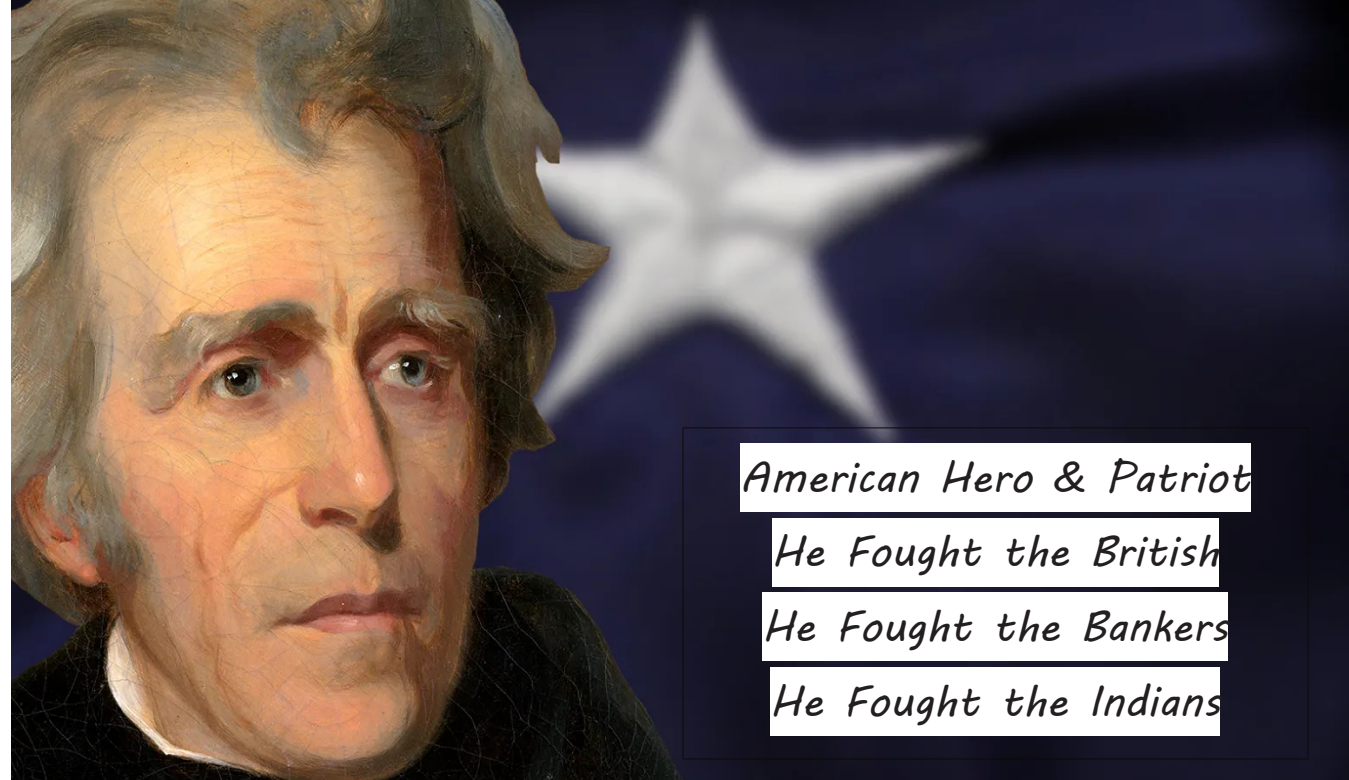

Andrew Jackson was the 7th president of the United States and was a hero to millions. He was a Christian man that believed America was created for White Europeans. Andrew Jackson was a lawyer, Congressman, U.S. Senator, judge on the Tennessee Supreme Court and the seventh president of the United States. Jackson also is given the credit of proposing the state's name, "Tennessee," when he was a member of the state's first convention which adopted Tennessee's constitution. As major general of the U.S.

Army he defeated the British in the Battle of New Orleans in 1815. The private soldiers said of him, "he is as tough as hickory," and he soon became known as "Old Hickory."

After the victorious Battle of New Orleans in the war of 1812 Jackson wrote his friend Robert Hays: *'It appears that the unerring hand of Providence shielded my men from the shower of balls, bombs, and*

Choosing wisely is very important. For some it seems hard to do. Our life is a life of decisions and learning to make the right decision is something that children need to be taught at an early age.

**However, even sometimes when we try to make the right decision it is still the wrong decision.**

This can happen in major crossroads of our life, but let me give a couple of minor decisions as an illustration.

For example if my computer is not working right. Knowing it is broken and wanting it to work right is the right decision and it is *not wrong* for me to try and fix it myself - but it would be the wrong decision.

If my car breaks down and I need to get it repaired is the right thing to do. I may even try to repair it myself - but it would be the wrong decision.

How about if I buy a house. It is a really good deal. It is a nice house and well within my budget. However it is in the middle of the ghetto. Wrong decision!

Now let us look at a major decision.

We are told by almost every church that we are



If you ask me to repair your car, you made a bad decision.

to *Love Everyone!* That sounds nice. After all how can loving people be bad?

So the words "*Everyone Welcome!*" is placed at the front of the church.

Isn't that nice?

*Love Wins!*

However "*Everyone welcome to come to church*" has morphed into, "*Everyone welcome to come to America!*"

We don't want to be mean - we want to be good Christians.

**Because we have accepted the delusion that we are to love everyone, we're being punished for making this wrong decision.**

Here is what happens when we make the wrong decision about loving everyone.

Deut 28:43-44 "The alien who is among you shall rise higher and higher above you, and you shall come down lower and lower. 44 He shall lend to you, but you shall not lend to him; he shall be the

I want you to pay attention to this word *lend*. It is from the Hebrew word *lavah*. When we see that word we think of the concept of borrowing and loaning. But that isn't what it means at all, even though all Bible translators translates *lavah* as that. Dr. James Strong in his widely accepted and respected Strong's Concordance of the Bible does

give "lend" as a secondary meaning. But the primary meaning of *lavah* is to *unite, twine or twist together*.

That is important!

That is exactly what has happened to America - a wrong decision has brought this calamity upon us and millions of aliens have flooded into our homeland. They are united against us but we are not united against them. They have become the head and we have become the tail.

In the very chapter where this warning is given - Deuteronomy 28 we are told of the opportunity we have to make the right decision or to make the wrong decision.

"Now it shall come to pass, if you will obey the voice of the Lord your God, and carefully obey His commandments the Lord your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. 2 And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God. . . (vs15) "But, if you do not obey the voice of the Lord your God, all these curses will come upon you and overtake you."

If we choose to follow the Lord we will be blessed, but if we decide to rebel against the Lord we will be cursed.

God isn't going to make these decisions for us. We (you and I) are to make the decision to choose right or to choose wrong, to chose good or to choose evil.

**Ancient Israel, like us today, was given the ability to choose to obey or not to obey.**

Consider, when a child makes a wrong decision the punishment may come from their parents. When they get older the punishment will come from the circumstances they created.

In America today we are suffering from the circumstances we have created. We really can't blame the alien. **We are the ones which made the decision to disobey** the commandments to love our God and love our people. (Matt 22:37-39)

The Bible tells us Proverbs 14:12 *"There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death."*

God has given us the power to choose between right and wrong - life or death.

The way I live my life might seem right to me . . .

but it would be best if I called upon the name of the Lord!

Deuteronomy 30:14-20 "But the word is very nigh unto thee, in thy mouth, and in thy heart, that thou **mayest do it**. 15 See, I have set before thee this day **life and death**, and good and evil; 16 In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it. 17

**But if thine heart turn away**, so that thou wilt not hear, but shalt be drawn away, and worship other gods, and serve them; 18 I denounce unto you this day, that ye shall surely perish, and that ye shall not prolong

your days upon the land, whither thou passest over Jordan to go to possess it. 19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing

and cursing: therefore **choose** life, that both thou and thy seed may live."

Again we are being advised to *choose* carefully.

Proverbs 12:15 The way of fools seems right to them, but the wise will listen to counsel.

Another way of saying this is that some will *choose* foolishness and others will *choose* wisdom!

Again, fixing my computer may seem like the right thing to do. It is not a sin for me to try to do my own computer repair, but it would be better for me to call Bob. I may want to repair my own automobile, no one says it is wrong or sinful to do my own repair - but it would be better to call a real mechanic.

Likewise the way I live my life might seem right to me but it would be best if I called upon the name of the Lord.

Our whole life is built on how well we choose between good and evil, foolishness or wisdom. Over the years I have heard young people says such things as *"Don't ask him (or her) he is just an old man!"* When in reality it should be *"Don't ask him - he is just a young guy. He doesn't have enough experience. Go ask that old guy."* Young parents have an enormous problem in that area regarding raising children.

Choosing wisdom is admittedly difficult, that is why we need to keep in touch with the Lord so making wisdom is our first instinct. We are told in Prov 3:5-6 "Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways knowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths."

rockets, when every ball and bomb from our guns carried with them a mission of death.' Concerning the same battle, Jackson wrote to Secretary of War James Monroe: 'Heaven, to be sure, has interposed most wonderfully in our behalf, and I am filled with gratitude, when I look back to what we have escaped.'

Jackson served two terms as president of the United States from 1829-1837. In 1832 he vetoed the Bank Renewal Bill, preventing the establishment of the Bank of the United States. He said that the federal bank would be detrimental to the freedoms of Americans; that it was "... dangerous to have such a concentration of power in the hands of a few men irresponsible to the people...Their power would be great...it would be more formidable and dangerous than the naval and military power of the enemy..." Jackson took the bold step of withdrawing the government's deposits from the Bank of the United States, which caused consternation and criticism. However by 1835 the national debt was paid off, a unique occurrence in the history of our nation, and at the end of this second term as president Jackson left a surplus in the Federal Treasury.

When Andrew Jackson was away in Washington, D.C he wrote to his wife of his faith: "I trust that the God of Isaac and of Jacob will protect you, and give you health in my absence. In Him alone we ought to trust; He alone can preserve and guide us through this troublesome world, and I am sure He will hear your prayers. We are told that the prayers of the righteous availeth much (James 5:16), and I add mine for your health and preservation until we meet again.' On March 4, 1833, in his Second Inaugural

Address, President Jackson stated: "...It is my fervent prayer to that Almighty Being...that He will so overrule all my intentions and actions and inspire the hearts of my fellow-citizens that we may be preserved from dangers of all kinds and continue forever a united happy people."

Jackson wrote to Mary upon the death of their first born: "...This charming babe was only given you from your Creator and benefactor...He has a right to take away, and we ought humbly to submit to His will and be always ready to say, blessed be His name. We have one consolation under this severe bereavement, that this babe is now in the bosom of its Savior."

If we want our lives and our children to be blessed it begins by choosing to "Trust in the Lord."

**When children make the wrong decision they want to blame someone else.**

When they get older they will still blame others for their misery. They may even the blame Devil. Or perhaps they will blame God when problems enter their lives.

I want you to understand, God is not punishing you. It is the law that is punishing you. Why because "Wages of sin is death!" (Rom 6:23)

God wants to bless you, but you have to make the right decisions!

**Sometimes the decision people make doesn't seem evil at the time but it may bring about an evil conclusion.**

For example: Buying a house in the ghetto would be a wrong real estate decision. I am going to give you another bad real estate decision recorded in the book of Numbers.

Israel was led out of Egypt through the enormous power of God. He parted the Red Sea and they walked through on dry land. When the Egyptian army came in after them, the wall of water crashed down upon them and wasted the Egyptian army. The military of Egypt was so devastated that Egypt had to bring home much of their scattered troops from Canaan to protect their home country. This left Canaan defenseless against the armies of Israel. (Num 14:9)

The wasting of the Egyptian army at the Red Sea was an awesome display of God's power. He also led Israel by a pillar of fire or by a cloud. At one point he caused water to gush out of the rock. He sent them quail and manna for food. He provided for their every need. They had every reason to trust fully upon the grace of God to be their protector.

**And now they stood on the border of the promised land and they were faced with the decision,** Should they trust God one more time! After witnessing the love, and mercy of the Lord, can they trust the Lord again? You would think that would be an easy decision. After all they saw all these miracles and still weren't sure if they could trust God.

**How many miracles has happened in your life?**

How many times has your life been spared? How many times? And yet we have trouble trusting in God. Psalm 18:2 "The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer;

my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower."

The act of placing your trust in the Lord is a decision. **When we have decisions in our lives we need to be careful to trust in the Lord and make our decision based on that trust.**

Of course, the children of Israel standing on the border of the Promise Land certainly saw the love, grace and mercy of the Lord displayed to them over and over again. They saw his deliverance from Egypt, they knew he was their provider and yet they still had trouble fully trusting in the Lord. But before we judge them too harshly, we need to examine our lives to see how much trust we place in the Lord our Provider!

Moses was instructed to send 1 man from each of the 12 tribes to go and search out the land. Much like Lewis and Clark searched out the Louisiana Purchase from May 14, 1804 until Sept 23, 1806. There were 12 "spies" on this expedition which lasted for 40 days.

Upon their return they issued their report to Moses. It is recorded in Numbers 13.

"They gave Moses this account: "We went into the land to which you sent us, and it does flow with milk and honey! Here is its fruit. 28 But the people who live there are powerful, and the cities are fortified and very large." Numbers 13:27 **Perhaps we are on the border of our promise land**

We look at the enemies which have risen against us and we have to admit they are powerful, and their cities (networks, corporations, government agencies) are fortified and very large. They look like giants - and to them we are like grasshoppers

Now we are faced with the decision, will we have faith and move forward, spreading the good news of white Christian Revival or should we turn back into the wilderness?

Ten of the spies were fearful and they wanted others to be fearful also. So they said the things that would cause people to be afraid. They started spreading *fear propaganda*, telling everyone how powerful the people in Canaan were. "They are GIANTS! They will crush us like a bug because we are small and tiny like grasshoppers."

There was only two faithful witnesses - Joshua and Caleb.

There was a certain understanding that America was a new homeland to the people of Europe. And thus the phrase "E pluribus unum" which is Latin for "Out of many, one" became the motto seen on the banner held by the Eagle in our great seal." J. Hector St. John de Crevecoeur, in his *Letters from an American Farmer* (1782) wrote "...whence came all these people? They are a mixture of English, Scotch, Irish, French, Dutch, Germans, and Swedes... What, then, is the American, this new man? He is either a European or the descendant of a European; hence that strange mixture of blood, which you will find in no other country. I could point out to you a family whose grandfather was an Englishman, whose wife was Dutch, whose son married a French woman, and whose present four sons have now four wives of different nations. He is an American."

Our forefathers certainly appreciated that America was the regathering place of the children of Europe. However, like all good things corruption often enters in. To the enemies of Christianity, America was no longer to be just the gathering place of Europeans (white people), but it was being transformed from the image of Europe to the image of the world.

It was to become a melting pot with invitations going to all the refuge of the world. Every alien race and alien religion was to be placed into the melting pot. And so began the process of replacement. It has taken years to get traction. But today we can see it in all of its ugliness.

The term "melting pot" wasn't created until the early 1900s and it wasn't even created in America. According to *Jews*

in America written by Jewish writer Arthur Hertzberg and given praise by Neil Ruben of *The B'nai B'rith* as well as Rabbi Yuter of *The National Jewish Post*, the term "the melting pot was not conceived in America. This new definition of America was constructed in England by Israel Zangwill."

before Moses and said, "We should go up and take possession of the land, for we can certainly do it." 31 But the men who had gone up with him said, "We can't attack those people; they are stronger than we are." 32 And they spread among the Israelites a bad report (Fake News) about the land they had explored. They said, "The land we explored devours those living in it. All the people we saw there are of great size."

Numbers 14:6-10 "But Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, who were among those who had spied out the land, tore their clothes; 7 and they spoke to all the congregation of the children of Israel, saying: "The land we passed through to spy out is an exceedingly good land. 8 If the Lord delights in us, then He will bring us into this land and give it

to us, 'a land which flows with milk and honey.' 9 **Only do not rebel against the Lord, nor fear the people of the land, for they are our bread;** ("chew them up") their protection has departed from them, and the Lord is with us. Do not fear them. 10 And all the congregation said to stone them with stones."

Israel made the terrible decision of not trusting the Lord. They chose to believe the Fake News. For that reason they were denied entrance to the promised land for 40 years. We can either choose righteousness or we can choose evil.

I am going to close with these final thoughts. Throughout Scripture we are told to choose. That is the power that our Sovereign God allows us. We can choose life or we can choose death.

We can choose to Trust in the Lord or we can choose to rebel. We are told that God is watching both the good and evil that is done in our lives .

May we always choose wisely. *END*

## JACKSON from page 7

On March 25, 1835 Andrew Jackson wrote in a letter: "...All who profess Christianity believe in a Savior, and that by and through Him we must be saved. We ought, therefore, to consider all good Christians whose walks correspond with their professions, be they Presbyterians, Episcopalian, Baptist, Methodist or Roman Catholic." On December 30 1836, President Jackson wrote to Mr. Andrew Donelson after hearing that his wife, Emily, had died: "It becomes our duty to submit to this heavy bereavement with due submission, and control our passions, submit to the will of God who holds our lives in His hand and say with humble and contrite hearts, "The Lord's will be done on earth as it is in heaven." Andrew Jackson stated: "We who are frequently visited by this chastening rod, have the consolation to read in the Scriptures that whomever He chasteneth He loveth, and does it for their good to make them mindful of their mortality and that this earth is not our abiding place; and afflicts us that we may prepare for a better, a happy immortality."

"Go to the Scriptures...the joyful promises it contains will be a balsam to all your troubles." On May 29, 1845, just a few weeks before he died, Andrew Jackson said: "Sir, I am in the hands of a merciful God. I have full confidence in His goodness and mercy...The Bible is true. I have tried to conform to its spirit as near as possible. Upon that sacred volume I rest my hope for eternal salvation, through the merits and blood of our blessed Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ." June 1, 1845, though in great pain, Jackson replied to those visiting him: "When I have suffered sufficiently, the Lord will then take me to Himself-but what are all my sufferings compared to those of the Blessed Savior, who died upon that cursed tree for me? Mine are nothing."

On June 8, 1845, just moments before his death, Jackson called his family and servants to his bedside and told them: "My

dear children, do not grieve for me; it is true, I am going to leave you; I am well aware of my situation. I have suffered much bodily pain, but my sufferings are but nothing compared with that which our blessed Redeemer endured upon the accursed Cross, that all might be saved who put their trust in Him...God will take care of you for me. I am my God's. I belong to Him."

The first clause of Andrew Jackson's Will states: "The Bible is true. Upon that sacred Volume I rest my hope of eternal salvation through the merits of our blessed Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. First, I bequeath my body to the dust whence it comes, and my soul to God who gave it, hoping for a happy immortality through the atoning merits of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Savior of the world." *END*

### WISDOM VERSUS FOLLY

In Proverbs 9, wisdom and folly are portrayed as two different women giving an invitation to those who were passing by. Each had prepared a lavish banquet and sent their maidens to the hilltop to call out travelers to stop in and eat and drink with her. Wisdom says to her guests that those that want understanding should forsake foolishness; they should live and seek understanding. The foolish woman also promises understanding and says that stolen waters are sweet and bread eaten in secret is pleasant (Prov. 9:16 -17), but the men do not know that "the dead are there and that her guests are in the depths of hell." (Prov. 9:18)

Both of these contrasts between wisdom and folly show that what is intended for one who wants understanding and who wants to have wisdom. Both women have used wisdom as the enticement to attend their banquet, but one leads to long life and one to hell. The passages refer to an adulterous woman as opposed to a virtuous woman. However, it also points to the one true God and the future invitation to the church. Paul, writing in Ephesians 4:4-6, talks about seven aspects of the church: one body, one spirit, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God, and one Father.

A wise man will follow God and will obey His commands. The wise woman provides bread and wine as the body and blood of Christ. The foolish

woman speaks of stolen waters, but only the living water of Jesus will lead to everlasting life. The foolish will follow after other stolen and hidden pleasures and bread, but they will end up in hell.

### THE CONTRAST

In Hebrew literature, diligence and wisdom are viewed as worthwhile pursuits and an integral part of life. It can bring one success, prosperity, loving relationships, righteous family life, and happy marriages, but even should none of these occur, a person who has diligence and pursues wisdom with the presupposition that the beginning of wisdom is fear of the Lord, then eternal life with God is the reward.

Likewise, laziness and folly can lead to a tumultuous life, poverty, unhappy relationships, and lack of achievement. But worst all, folly which can be a slow and creeping thing, can lead to eternal damnation.

### CONCLUSION

The authors of the poetic books sought to teach the Hebrew people about the meaning of life and ways in which they could be all that God wanted them to be. To be a people of dominion and to work and live for God was an essential feature of life. In fact, the foundation of life, and to neglect these duties was to fail God. Thus, wisdom and diligence are paramount as we strive to live up to God's expectations. *END*
