A Biblical New Year's Resolution

As the new year rises upon us, many of our like-minded white brothers and sisters behold the condition of our nation with grave concern. We see a land once grounded in the statutes of the Almighty now drifting under influences foreign to the covenant entrusted to our ancestors. The schools, the courts, the halls of legislation, the centers of commerce,



and the engines of culture all bear the marks of forces that do not honor the God of Israel nor the order He established for His people. To us, it appears as though a shadow has settled upon the land, and the likeness of Sodom and Gomorrah has returned in the twenty-first century, recalling the warnings of

Genesis 18 and 19.

As in the days of Noah, practices once condemned are now celebrated openly, even within churches that claim the name of Christ. We witness the unraveling of households, the rise of violence, the spread of corruption, and the bold defiance of God's commandments. We see a spirit at work that teaches every man to decide right and wrong for himself, echoing Judges 21:25: **"In those days there was no king in Israel: every man did that which was right in his own eyes."** This spirit, which exalts human will above divine law, has led our nation into confusion, instability, and moral decay.

Standing at the threshold of a new year, we ask what we can do. Should we enter the political arena? Should we withdraw and separate ourselves? Should we warn, teach, or call others to repentance? The answer is not the same for every household, for each has been given a calling, a talent, and a place in the unfolding plan of Christ. But all must seek wisdom from above, remembering James 1:5: **"If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him."**

At such a time, our hearts return to the words Paul wrote to the Philippians. These were Roman and Greek descendants of the Israelites. They were surrounded by cultic paganism. Yet, despite the lack of believers, through Paul's witness, a church was established in the household of Lydia, a prosperous woman and the city's first convert. Later, Paul reminded the new Christians there, in Philippians 2:12–16: **"Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure. Do all things without murmurings and disputings: That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a**

crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world; Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain."

Here lies our New Year's resolution: to shine as lights in a nation grown dark. But before a lamp can shine, the vessel must be cleansed. The work begins within the household of Israel. We must examine our own hearts, confront our own failings, and repent before we presume to correct others. The words of Jesus in Matthew 7:1–5 speak plainly: **"Judge not, that ye be not judged... first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye."** This is not a call to silence but a call to purification. Only the one who has humbled himself before God can stand as a guide to others.

Thus the first resolution is to work out our salvation (Meaning to actively live our faith) The second is to do so "with fear and trembling." Many teachers in our day reject the fear of the Lord, preferring a message of comfort without conviction. But Scripture speaks otherwise. Acts 9:31 declares: **"Then had the churches rest... and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied."** Proverbs 1:7 proclaims: **"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge."** Proverbs 9:10 affirms: **"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom."** Proverbs 8:13 states: **"The fear of the Lord is to hate evil."** Proverbs 14:26–27 teaches: **"In the fear of the Lord is strong confidence... The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life."** Proverbs 16:6 declares: **"By the fear of the Lord men depart from evil."** Proverbs 22:4 promises: **"By humility and the fear of the Lord are riches, and honour, and life."**

We speak of a child who ignores the parents' warnings and runs into danger. Without fear of consequences, destruction follows. So it is with a nation that no longer fears God. Without the fear of the Lord, wisdom departs, evil becomes enticing, repentance fades, and the heart grows cold. A people without fear of God becomes a people easily led astray.

But once this fear is restored, God begins His

I am not knowledgeable enough to know which is most credible. But I think we all know that Valentine's Day is a great day to express your love and devotion to that special person in your life.

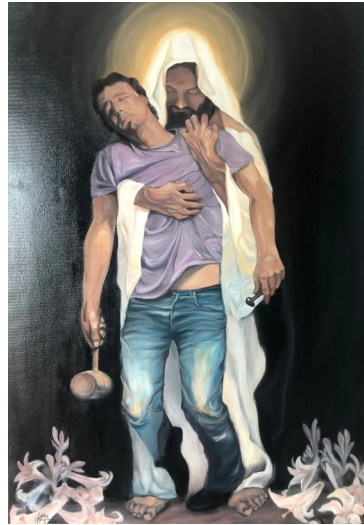
My wife and I always give each other a Valentine's card. Sometimes I buy those super big cards. You know, the kind that takes up the back of a pick-up truck.

Come Visit us!

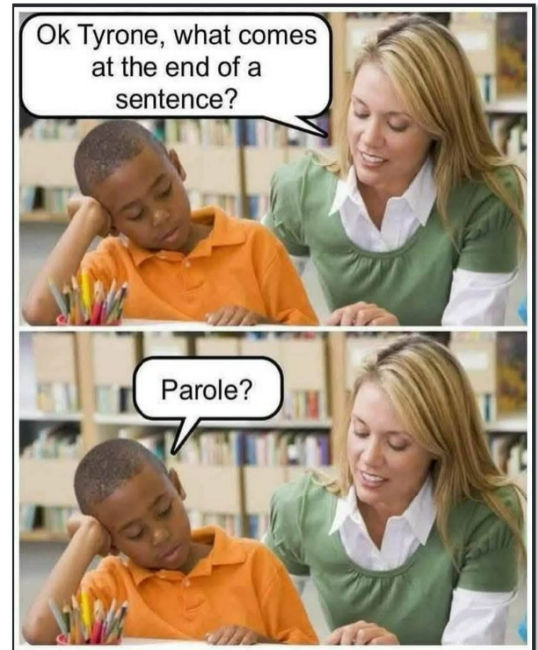

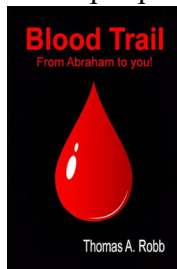


Columbus Did That!

work within the believer. Strength rises. Purpose awakens. The covenant identity of our people can be renewed. We remember Paul's assurance in Philippians 1:6: **"He which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ."** We recall Philippians 4:13: **"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me."** Power is given to those who seek it - power through prayer, as in Ephesians 6:18; power through Scripture, as in 2 Timothy 3:16-17; power through the armor of God described in Ephesians 6:10-17: **"Put on the whole armour of God..."**

Yet this power does not release us from duty. We must act. We must discipline ourselves, guard our households, and walk in obedience. We must not fear the institutions of men, for our strength does not come from them. Our calling as the Covenant people of God is to stand as a remnant, a beacon, a people set apart for the purposes of God. Jeremiah 31:33 **"But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will**

put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people." This is repeated in Hebrews 10:16 word for word which demonstrates that God has not forgotten our people.

Our people cry out for hope. Many wander blindly, never hearing the call to repentance. But God desires His sons and daughters to awaken, to come to their senses, and to awaken others, echoing Romans 13:11-12: "And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep... The night is far spent, the day is at hand."

And so our resolution for the new year is set forth: to shine more brightly than before, to walk more faithfully in the covenant, to strengthen our identity as the people of God, and to stand firm in a nation that has lost its way. For only by renewing ourselves can we light the path for others.

Though the times are dark and the nation falters, the promise remains. God grants power to those who seek Him. If His people will approach Him with fear and trembling, discipline themselves with His word, claim their heritage, and recognize the need for repentance - both personal and national - they will shine as lights in the world, fulfilling the purpose for which they were called as we continue into this new year. END

So Peter is put to the test - "Do you love me?"

Sometimes husbands and wives will ask each other, "Do you love me?" The wife hollers out from the kitchen, "Do you love me?" The joke I hear is the husband hollers back, "Of course I love you - I'm your husband - that's my job!"

It may sound redundant - but I like it when my wife says she loves me. I know she does. She takes care of me well - but I still like to hear the words.

Jesus likes to hear those words also!

I heard the story of a woman telling her husband, "Why don't you ever say, you love me?" His reply may have been accurate - but still foolish.

Husband: "Remember when we got married and I said I love you."

Wife: "Yes, I do remember."

Husband: "Well if anything ever changes I'll let you know."

He is still in recovery!

Matt 22:35-40 tells us how we can love Jesus. "Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him (Jesus) a question, tempting him, and saying, 36 Master, which is the great commandment in the law? 37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. 40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets."

The young lawyer thought Jesus was going to give him some law that he was required to obey. But Jesus didn't do that. Keep in mind the young man did not ask Jesus what the second commandment was - he only asked what the first commandment was. But the wisdom of Jesus was aware that the first answer needed a definition - an explanation. Because if Jesus did not give the meaning, people would give all kinds

of examples of what a person needed to do to prove they love the Lord "with all their heart, and with all their soul, and with all their mind."

Some would say, "You have to use the sacred name." "You have to keep the true Sabbath." "You have to keep feast days." "You have to be circumcised." "You have to be baptized." "You have to stop eating pork." "You have to stop celebrating the pagan holidays of Christmas and Easter (some say Valentine)." And I am sure there are many other commandments that someone will claim you have to obey to prove you love God.

So Jesus told us that the way to prove you love him is to love your neighbor. Those same

people (sheep) that Jesus told Peter to love.

Leviticus 19 shows us our neighbors are our kinsmen. 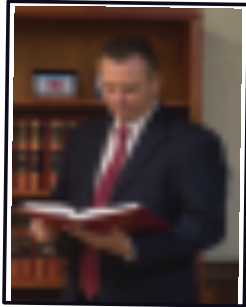

Here is a photo of Ben Hecht. Hecht was an American screenwriter, director, producer, playwright, journalist, and novelist.



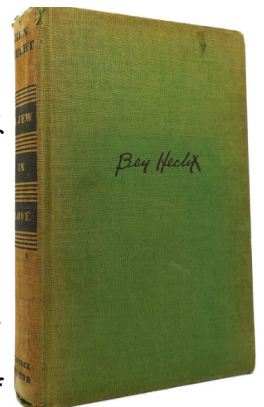
He was also Jewish and an enthusiastic Zionist. During his long career from 1911 to his death in 1964 he authored 35 books, worked on over 120 screenplays and was labeled "Mr Hollywood."

Hecht also was active in the early civil rights movement, combating White Supremacy.

In July 1941, Hecht began campaigning for America's support for the Soviet Union.

In 1931, Hecht published a Novel titled, "A Jew in love"

While having a successful Hollywood career and the receiving many awards his hatred for Jesus Christ is revealed on page 121 of *A Jew in Love*. I have an original in my library. Out of the evil spirit that was in his head he wrote the following disgusting thoughts.



"One of the finest things ever done by the mob was the crucifixion of Christ. Intellectually it was a splendid gesture. But trust the mob to bungle. If I'd have been there, if I'd have had charge of executing Christ, I'd have handled it differently. You see, what I would have done was had him shipped to Rome and fed to the lions. They could never have made a savior out of mince meat. I would do the same thing to the radicals today."
